

How to Draw Star Wars

DARTH MAUL

MB-RA-7 here to instruct you on how to draw Darth Maul. Are you brave enough to draw the Sith Lord? Of course — you're a Jedi!

Since Darth Maul is a martial arts master, he's fun to draw in action.



1

Begin by drawing a stick figure lightly and loosely. His right shoulder should be angled downward, his feet far apart, and his knees bent — as if he has just swung his lightsaber.

Add shapes over the top of your stick Maul. Don't use soft, curvy lines. Instead, draw harsh, angled lines to make him more menacing.

Once you've built Maul's body with shapes, begin drawing his outfit on top of it. Give him a loose cloak so he can move easily when he's fighting. Darken the lines you want, and erase the ones you don't need.
