

Because Darth Maul is really an actor (Ray Park) wearing makeup, it makes sense to draw a person then add the makeup. Here are some general directions for drawing heads:

Now, head is great to draw. You can always make your work with tattoos.



Eyes should be in the center of the head. The distance between each eye is equal to an eye's length. Halfway between the eyes and chin is where his nose ends. Ears are generally as long as the distance from the eyes to the nose.

For his menacing expression, the Sith Lord's teeth are gritted together, his nostrils flared, his eyes narrowed.

His face tattoos and horns have been added. Notice that his teeth are starting to look pretty grimy.

The tattoos have been darkened, and shading has been added to his horns for texture. His pupils are very dark to make them look scary. His teeth look disgusting because he never brushes!

Now all he needs is a nose ring.

Once you have a basic drawing, start adding details to his face, lightsaber, and boots. Keep outlines thicker and lines for small details thinner.

Make areas on his belt and boots lighter than the rest of his outfit to keep him from appearing solid black. Add some shading around his lightsaber blades for a glowing effect.

Now add details to his face and head. You may want to have your lightsaber handy, just in case he comes to life and tries to jump off of the page!
